Election of Officers of the Board

- The Modus Operandi foresees the PCB to elect the current Vice-Chair, Netherlands, to the position of Chair for a term of one year starting on 1 January 2026.
- This meeting of the PCB Coordinating Board must also elect a Vice-Chair and a Rapporteur for a term of one year starting 1 January 2026.
- On 10 December 2025, the Secretariat received an expression of interest from the Philippines for the position of Vice-Chair.
- On 12 December 2025, the Secretariat received an expression of interest from Kenya, endorsed by the Africa Group, for the position of Rapporteur.



New delegates for PCB NGO Delegation

The Orientation, Accountability and Recruitment (OAR) Working Group of the NGO Delegation together with the Communication and Consultation Facility (CCF), manages the annual process of recruiting incoming Delegates to fill in the slots vacated by outgoing Delegates.

In 2025, two delegates were eligible to continue for a third year in the NGO Delegation. The delegation members assessed the eligible delegates for an extension of the term of service. All two delegates were granted a third-year extension in line with the maximum term of service conforming to ECOSOC resolution 1995/2.

- Following this process, the NGO Delegation confirmed a total of two vacancies to serve the term from 2026 to
 2027 one for the Africa region and one for the Latin America and the Caribbean region.
- The PCB NGO Delegation met to make the final selection of candidates on 13 November 2025.
