Benefits of holding PCB meetings outside of Geneva

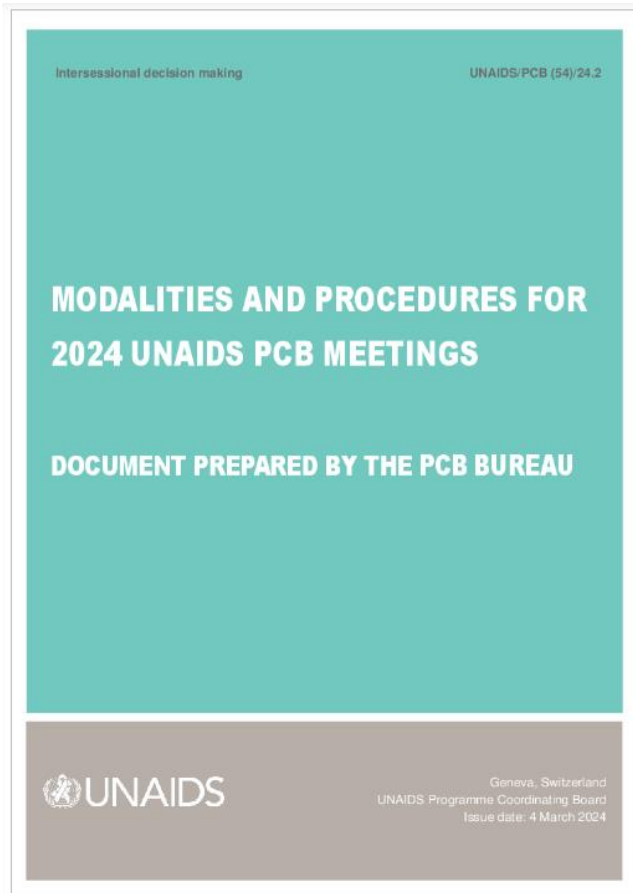

Field visits by PCB members to better understand the reality of the epidemic and the work of UNAIDS;
