55th UNAIDS PROGRAMME COORDINATING BOARD (PCB) MEETING

10-12 December 2024, Nairobi, Kenya

	INTRODUCTION	
	This information note for the 55th UNAIDS Programme Coordinating Board (PCB) meeting has been prepared to facilitate active participant engagement and ensure the efficient conduct of the meeting. It is intended to be read in conjunction with the "Modalities and Procedures for the 2024 UNAIDS PCB Meetings" (UNAIDS/PCB (54)/24.2).	
	PCB MEETING	
Date and venue	The 55th PCB meeting will be held in person at the Nairobi Serena Hotel (Processional Way, Nairobi, Kenya) from 10 to 12 December 2024. Limited online access via Zoom will be available for meeting members, participants, and observers who are unable to attend in person.	
	The plenary sessions will be held in The Ballroom, while the drafting sessions will take place in the Amani Room. All in-person participants will receive a map of the hotel upon arrival and registration.	
	PCB FIELD VISITS	
	On <b>Monday, 9 December 2024</b> , in-person registered PCB members, participants and observers will have the opportunity to go to various field visits.	
Date and venue	The PCB field visits provide participants with direct exposure to the realities of the HIV epidemic and response and direct engagement with stakeholders in the response. The visits are an opportunity to see and discuss the work undertaken by the Joint Programme together with national and international partners, providing significant added value to the discussions at the 55th PCB meeting.	
	Participants must sign up for the field visit of their choice when registering for the PCB meeting in Indico. Each field visit site will have limited participation, and places will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis. For delegations of more than 1 delegate, request to split between the different sites to allow a diverse composition on each site.	
	The departure to the sites will be from the Serena Hotel, with specific times provided in advance for each site. Lunch will be provided.	



	1. The Bar Hostess Empowerment & Support Program: The BHESP is a community- based organization in Kenya led by female sex workers. It focuses on empowering marginalized groups, particularly female sex workers and other key populations, by advocating for their health rights and reducing vulnerability to HIV and other sexually transmitted infections. (Max number of participants: 20)
	2. Health Option for Young Men on HIV/STIs: HOYMAS is a critical player in the HIV response for men who have sex with men (MSM) in Kenya, providing essential health services, legal support, and advocacy in a highly stigmatized environment. (Max number of participants: 40)
5 Field visit sites	<b>3. Ruiru Government of Kenya Prisons Medically Assisted Therapy Clinic:</b> The MAT Clinic is a vital component of Kenya's approach to addressing the health needs of people who inject drugs, especially within the prison system. The clinic provides life-saving treatment, reduces HIV transmission among incarcerated PWID, and advocates for a more supportive policy environment for harm reduction. (Max number of participants: 50)
	<b>4. Mathari Medically Assisted Therapy Clinic:</b> The Mathare clinic was the first MAT clinic in Kenya to support PWID. It offers free integrated services for PWID, including opioid substitution (methadone) therapy; HIV testing services; ART; condom distribution; vaccination, diagnosis and management of viral hepatitis; prevention and treatment of tuberculosis; and overdose prevention and treatment. (Max number of participants: 30)
	5. MAONO Africa Centre for Transformation AYP Programme: Maono Africa offers a range of services aimed at promoting social change and development focusing on HIV prevention for adolescents and young people. Interventions include using sports and arts as tools for creating awareness of HIV prevention & providing psychosocial support, conducting workshops on HIV prevention and sexual reproductive health, facilitating information sharing through focus group discussions, and providing linkages and referrals to essential services for adolescents and young people. (Max number of participants: 50)

	The eTA is mandatory for all foreign visitors. Passport holders from the following EAC countries are exempted from applying to an eTA: Burundi, Democratic Republic of Congo, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania and Uganda	
	Members of the Diplomatic Missions and International Organizations accredited to Kenya, Laissez Passer document holders are exempt from payment for the eTA.	
	It is recommended to apply for your eTA 2 weeks prior to travel. Processing time is three (3) working days but in some cases it may take longer.	
Essential requirements for eTA application	<ul> <li>Valid passport for at least six (6) months after your planned date of arrival into Kenya, with at least one blank page.</li> <li>Selfie or passport-type photo.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Contact information, email address and phone number.</li> <li>Details of your arrival and departure itinerary.</li> <li>Accommodation booking confirmation(s).</li> <li>Credit card, debit card or other means of payment.</li> </ul>

Travel arrangements	<ul> <li>In accordance with <u>the PCB Modus Operandi</u>, UNAIDS will cover the travel costs and per diem for PCB Members (but not Observers) in connection with the attendance at this meeting for: <ul> <li>(1) one representative from each developing country.</li> <li>(1) one from each country with an economy in transition; and</li> <li>(1) one representative from each of the nongovernmental organizations represented on the Board.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Kindly note that to ensure cost-effectiveness and expedite visa processing, the Secretariat will not be able to fund the travel of delegates unless their names and contact details are received by the deadline of Monday, 4 November 2024.</li> </ul>

Travel to Kenya	The international airport in Nairobi is Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA). All international and domestic flights to and from Nairobi will arrive and depart from this airport. Participants who wish to travel domestically within Kenya can take flights from JKIA or from Wilson Airport, which operates domestic routes. Jomo Kenyatta International Airport provides services for both international and domestic flights, with numerous daily connections to major destinations within the country.

Security information & advisory	<ul> <li>Collaboration between the UNAIDS Security Advisor, the United Nations Department of Safety and Security (UNDSS), and Kenyan authorities ensures the highest level of safety for participants.</li> <li>A cross-departmental Steering Committee for the 55th PCB logistics has been established under the leadership of the PCB Chair from Kenya. Within this framework, a dedicated subcommittee on Security is being formed to coordinate all safety measures for the meeting.</li> <li>A comprehensive security note, complementing the logistics note, will be shared with participants.</li> <li>Additionally, a virtual security briefing will be organized closer to the meeting date for those attending in person.</li> <li>The security note will be treated as a living document, with updates provided as the meeting approaches.</li> </ul>		



Health measures	<ul> <li>While no COVID-19 or Mpox testing is currently required, we will inform participants in case of any changes to travel health guidelines leading up to the meeting.</li> <li>It is advised to bring personal protective equipment such as masks, hand sanitizers, and other hygiene products as per individual preference.</li> <li>The WHO advises travelers to Kenya to ensure they have valid yellow fever immunization.</li> <li>It is strongly recommended to consult your national health authorities or local travel clinics for health advice and vaccination requirements. 	<b>M-Pesa</b> (M for mobile, pesa meaning money in Kiswahili) allows users to deposit, withdraw, transfer money, and pay for goods and services using a mobile device. Transactions are charged a small fee. It's convenient for extended stays—you can pay for taxis, groceries, restaurant bills, utility bills, phone credit, and more. To sign up, bring your ID and a deposit to any Safaricom or Airtel store.	
	Kenya has a standard voltage of 240 V at a frequency of 50Hz, and a type G socket. Plug- sockets are shaped as seen in the picture below. Most plugs with two prongs can also be used.
