Financial Highlights

- Ninth set of financial statements prepared according to IPSAS accounting standards
- Unmodified audit opinion provided by the external auditors
- UNAIDS Statement of Internal Control (SIC) included in the 2020 Audited Financial Statements.
- Financial situation has been relatively stable during 2020 but remains tight







2020 Financial Highlights (Core Income & Expenditure)

- Core income totaling US\$ 194 million mobilized in 2019 compared to US\$ 184 million mobilized in 2019 and US\$ 189 million in 2018
- Total core expenditures (expenses and encumbrances) amounted to US\$ 183.4 million compared to US\$ 181 million in 2019
- Core Secretariat expenditure and encumbrances amounted to US\$136.3 million against an approved core budget of US\$ 140 million.
- The net fund balance on 31 December 2020 stood at US\$ 112 million (US\$ 101 million end of 2019) an increase of US\$ 11 million
- Net fund balance at end of 2020 is US\$ 5 million higher than approved min level of US\$ 107 million).

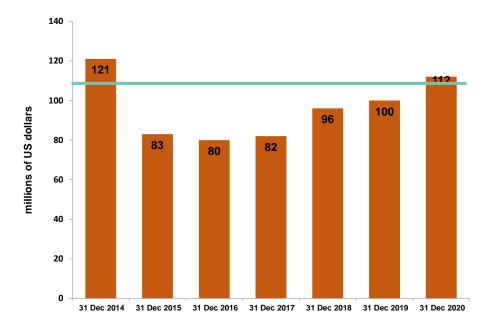


EXPENDITURE



Management of the core fund balance

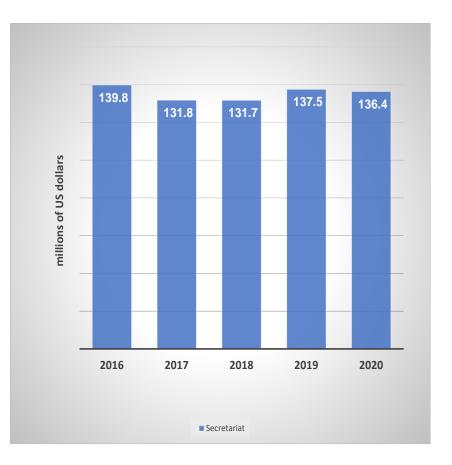
- At the end of December 2020, the net fund balance stood at US\$ 112 million compared to US\$ 100 million end 2019 and US\$ 96 million end of 2018
- US\$ 5 million higher than the PCB approved minimum level of US\$ 107 million approved in 2015.
- US\$ 32 million more than at end 2016
- Ability to operate smoothly even with an income reduction in 2021.





UBRAF Core Secretariat expenditures 2016 - 2020

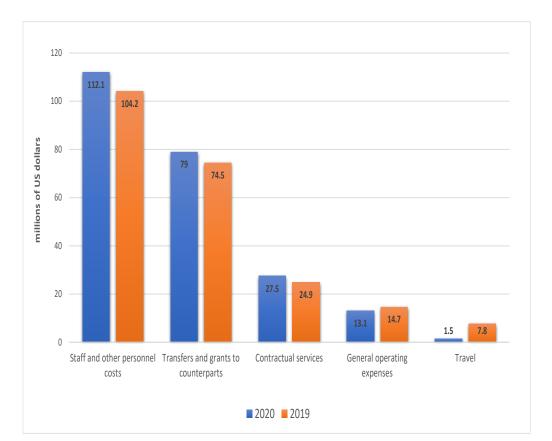
- Continued emphasis on cost effectiveness and cost containment
- Secretariat 2020 core expense and encumbrances of US\$ 136.4 million
- Representing 97.5% implementation rate against the approved core budget of US\$ 140 million.





Expenditure by cost category – All sources of funds

- Overall level of expenditure under major expense categories in 2020, is higher than that of 2019 expense except for travel expense.
- Increases were mainly under staff costs and transfers to counterparts, and contractual services





2020 - 2021 Budget

- Final biennial workplan and budget of 2016-2021 UNAIDS Strategy and UBRAF
- UNAIDS maintains its target of a fully funded UBRAF of US\$ 242 million (core budget of US\$ 187 million and supplemental funds of US\$ 55 million)
- Annual core budget of US\$ 187 million; (US\$ 47 million for Cosponsors and US\$ 140 million for the Secretariat)
- Supplemental core funds to address particular epidemic and country context of US\$ 55 million





Developments in 2021 – Income and Expenditure

- The net fund balance 2020 enabled the Secretariat to fully fund the 2021 Cosponsors core allocation of US\$ 47 million (including the country envelopes) as per the approved budget.
- So far in 2021, US\$ 86.4 million has been recorded as core income. It is estimated that US\$166 million core will be raised in 2021
- Additional efforts needed to achieve the resource mobilization target of US\$ 187 million.
- Total core expenditure and encumbrances as of today is US\$ 120 million (Cosponsors US\$ 47 million and Secretariat US\$ 73 million)
